Seasonal Arts & Crafts: Guy Fawkes	We get creative & delve into the history behind bonfire night. We'll create a Guy Fawkes & Houses of Parliament art mural using a range fun of art mediums, including smashing cotton balls soaked in paint to create fireworks! Zombie Scavenger Hunt	Zombie body part scavenger hunt is not as scary as it sounds! It's up to your team to find all the missing pieces & recreate your own team zombie, then tell the story of your zombie to the group	Autumn seasonal celebration, sensory play, imagination & creation, storytelling, teamwork
Autumn Campfire Cookout	American-style pumpkin seed toasting around the campfire. A healthy camping snack & a good use of those seeds you collect from carving pumpkins	Autumn seasonal celebration, sensory, outdoor play & education, campfire cooking & fire safety, health & wellbeing
Nerf Games: Zombie Apocalypse	A spooky Nerf session of Zombie Apocalypse – some light-hearted storytelling, then working together to fight the hoard to protect your base!	High energy games, teamwork, physical exercise, strategy & game play
Harry Potter: Quidditch	Playing a Quidditch tournament in the style of Harry Potter. Let the sorting hat choose your house, then grab a broomstick! Who will be victorious? Gryffindor, Slytherin, Hufflepuff or Ravenclaw?	Storytelling, popular culture, teamwork, physical exercise & coordination
Viking Kubb	Playing the lawn game Kubb, an old Viking game! The objective is to knock over wooden blocks, known as Kubb, by throwing sticks at them as a team. Which team will come out on top to claim to be the ultimate Viking clan?	Hands on history, Vikings, game play, social, hand eye coordination
Bonkers Conkers	What is a conker? Learn about the tree it comes from & its history, then set up some conkers & play the traditional British game called conkers	Nature & plants, hand eye coordination, social & teamwork, British & Irish playground history & outdoor play
Bushcraft: Shelter Build	A classic bushcraft shelter building session. Build a camp/den/survival shelter in small teams, get creative & be resourceful! Anything goes!	Safety skills & risk management, bushcraft, teamwork & social skills, physical exercises, hand eye coordination
Extreme Weather Survival Dash	Decisions under pressure are difficult & having a good team could save you. Spin the wheel to determine which survival scenario you've landed in – the squirrel apocalypse? Arctic Tundra? Dash to the survival kit to grab what you think you'll need, then work out how you'll use it to survive your survival scenario	Geography & weather, survival skills, risk management, social & teamwork
Nature Ninjas: Leaf Monsters	Let's talk about foraging & what it means. We'll be searching the playgrounds high & low for the spookiest leaves, then making them into Leaf Monsters to take home	Arts & crafts, safe foraging, fun, social skills, leaf identification, appreciation of nature
Mega Games	An autumn term games special with some of our favourite Outdoors Project games - Zombie Step, Skittle Game & Among Us	Social skills - confidence speaking in front of a group & respecting each other's opinions, hand-eye coordination, strategy
