


Join each number to the same number of spots.


#### Join the dots

Join the dots in order from 1 to 10.




What you need to know At this stage your child is learning to:

- know the sequence of numbers 1 to 10.




Say the a sound. Draw a line from the letter a to each picture that starts with that sound.




# Phonic sounds t and p

Say the **t** sound. Draw a line from the letter **t** to each picture that starts with that sound.




Say the p sound. Draw a line from the letter p to each picture that starts with that sound.




# Phonic sounds i and n

 Say the word for each picture. Draw a circle round the letter sound it starts with.




Well done! Now colour the next star.




## Phonic sounds m and d

Say the **m** sound. Circle the pictures that do **not** start with the **m** sound.




 Say the d sound. Colour the pictures that do not start with the d sound.



Say the **g** sound. Draw a line from the letter **g** to each picture that starts with that sound.




Say the o sound. Draw a line from the letter o to each picture that starts with that sound.




### Phonic sounds c and k
