## Oral Blending and Segmenting

Home Learning Challenges

Listen carefully as you sound out these words: pin, sat, tap, net. How many letter sounds are in each word? Try counting on your fingers, such as 'c-a-t, 1-2-3'.


Play a listening and drawing game with a grown-up. Take it in turns to sound out a word and then the other person has to draw the item! Try these words: hat, sun, ten, pan, box.

With a grown-up, play a listening game about a visit a farm. Begin by saying 'I went to the farm and I saw...' - instead of saying the animal name, split the word up into its letter sounds. The other person has to identify the animal by blending the sounds together. For example: 'I went to the farm and I saw a c-a-t. It's a cat!' Try the animals shown in the picture below.
