**Five Minute Boredom Busters** 

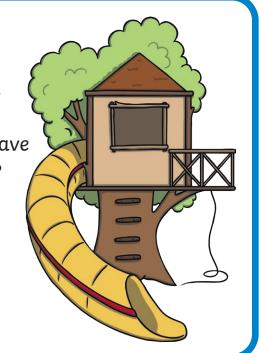
How many things can you find around your house or garden that are blue?

Using a camera, take close up photos of things like the cushion on the sofa or the wallpaper pattern.

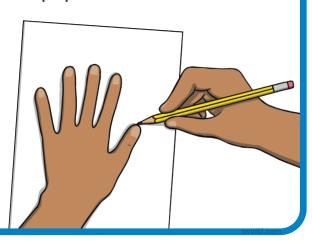
Can someone in your house work out what those

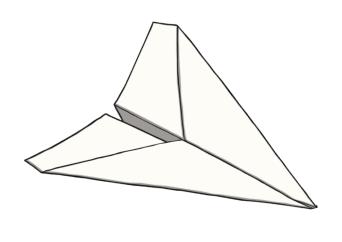
Draw around your hand on a piece of paper.

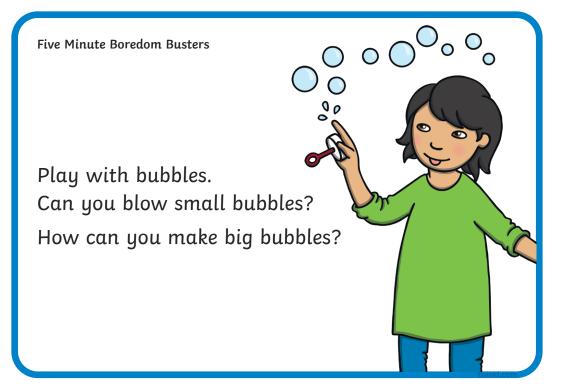
Make a paper aeroplane. Use these <u>instructions</u>.

## Five Minute Boredom Busters

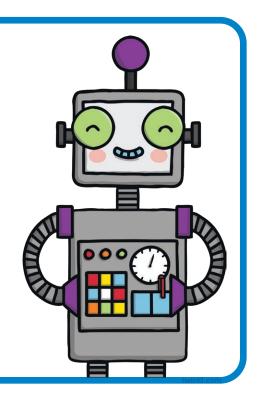

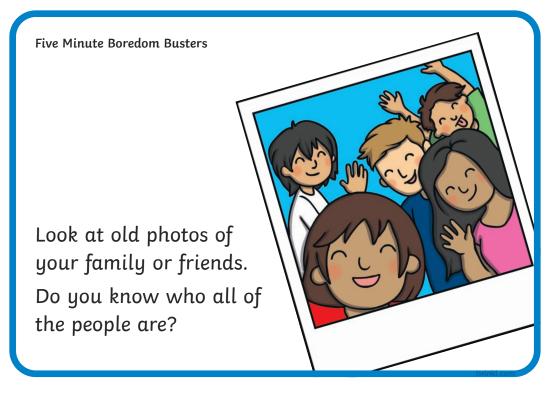


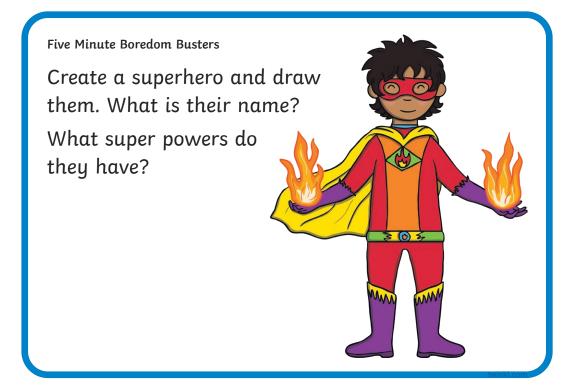
Five Minute Boredom Busters
